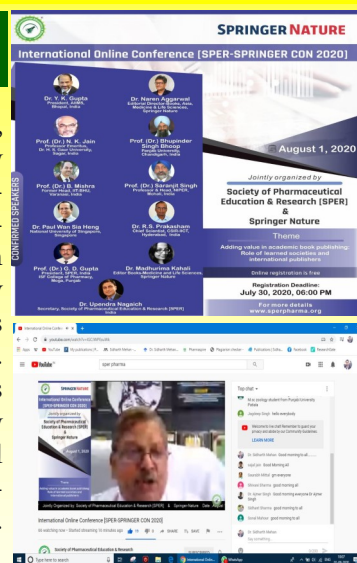


## SPER SPRINGER CON 2020

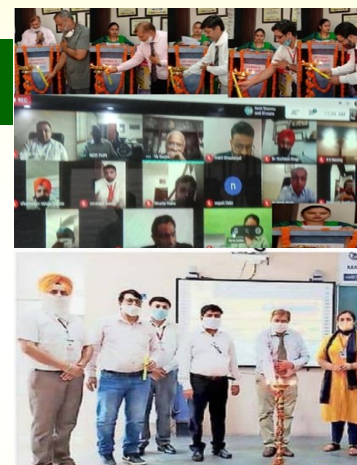


## E-ALUMNI MEET, PHARMACOVIGILANCE CONFERENCE AND STUDENT INDUCTION

## BOOK /BOOK CHAPTER

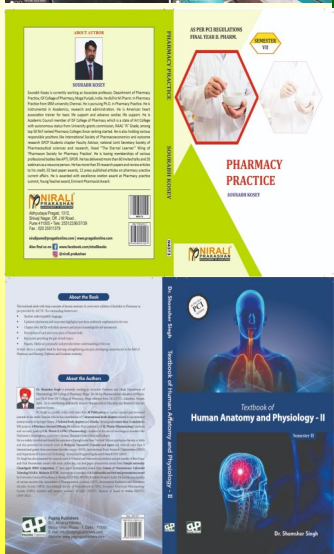

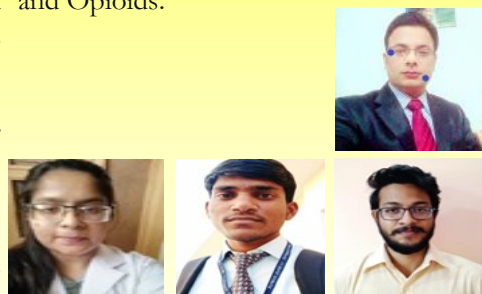
