
## SCHOLARSHIPS OFFERED BY THE ISFCP

The list of various scholarships offered are as follows:



S.No.	Scholarships	Detail
1.	Late Smt. Manju Garg Memorial	Two scholarships of the value of Rs. 5000/-, awarded every year among the resident students who have obtained a First Division in the last examination taken and are in need of financial help.  The scholarship money may be utilized for the payment of hostel charges, purchase of books etc.



7.	Alumni Ward scholarships	Rs. 10,000/- per year scholarship to alumni ward if taken admission in any branch.
8.	Alumni Scholarships	Rs. 10,000/- per year scholarships to alumni if taken admission in higher education (B. Pharm. to M. Pharm. and Pharm. D. program)
